3 things you need to know (about Mark 1:29-45)

- the deep kingdom transformation of jesus doesn't thrive in the hype
 - "and he would not permit the demons to speak, because they knew him" (v.34)
 - the hype is the hindrance to the real work of kingdom transformation
- 2. That transformation is so vital, so urgent and so challenging

that to uncover that it requires a determined pursuit of prayer

- "and there he prayed" (v.35)
- prayer is the doorway to the real work
 of wonder, relational richness, and life change
- 3. jesus is a trustworthy leader in the journey of transformation.

the kingdom goal he chases is soaked with compassion

& generosity

- "I do choose" (v.41)
- a willingness to care and to give is part of the journey,

my challenge then, and yours

is to find a deeper place to live from, below the hype guarding & prioritising creative practises of prayer, as a matter of urgency

while actively embrace compassion and generosity toward others

Jesus is the model of this,

& Jesus is the bringer of this.
